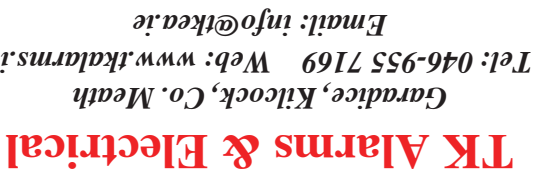

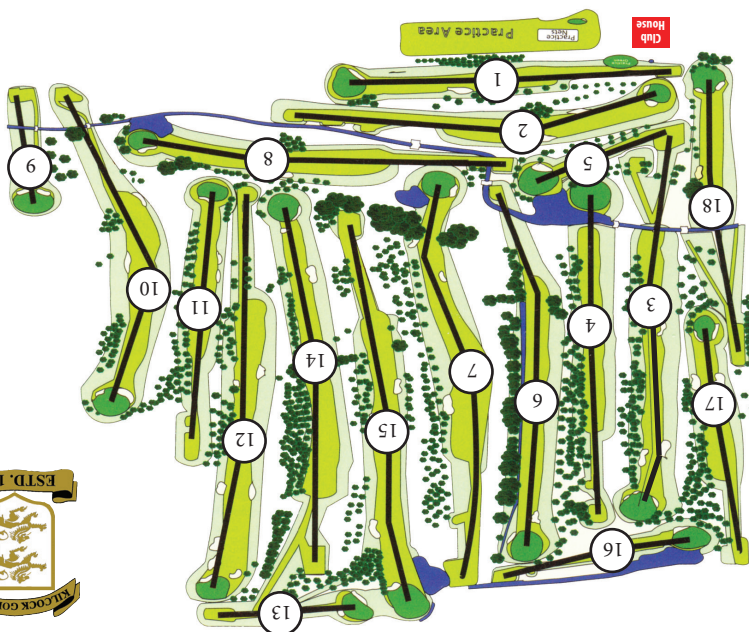

- Out of Bounds:** Outside the course, or any white posts defining the out of bounds, the practice area, putting green, carpark and Club House area.
- No Play Zone:** The areas defined by NPZ signs are No Play Zones which are treated as abnormal course conditions. Free relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 16.1f.
- Prohibiting Play from Fringe of Wrong Green:** When taking wrong green relief from a green other than the green being played, the wrong green is defined to include the area of fairway within two club-lengths from the edge of the putting green. This means when taking relief under Rule 13.1f, the nearest point of complete relief must avoid interference from this area in addition to the wrong green.
- All Roads and Paths Treated as Obstructions:** All roads and paths on the course, even if not artificially surfaced, are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.
- Treating Movable Objects to Be Immovable:** All seats and tee markers are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.
- Prohibiting Play from Wrong Tee Box:** A Ball Coming to Rest on the playing surface of a tee, other than that being played from, must be lifted, and dropped at the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole.
- Drop Zone Hole 3:** When the ball crosses the penalty area left of the 3rd green, this Drop Zone is the only relief option available under penalty of one stroke if you choose to take a penalty drop.
- Drop Zones Holes 5:** If the ball crosses the penalty area to the right of the BLUE post, The Drop Zone is the only relief option available under penalty of one stroke if you choose to take a penalty drop. If the ball crosses the penalty area to the left of the BLUE post, normal rules apply for Red penalty areas.
- Drop Zone Hole 6:** There is Drop Zone for the penalty area left of the 6th fairway. The Drop Zone is the only relief option available under penalty of one stroke if you choose to take a penalty drop.
- General Penalty for Breach of Local Rule:**
- Stroke Play - 2 Strokes
- Match Play - Loss of Hole
