3. Treasury report: Presented by Cormac O Toole.

- Cormac addressed Pat Mahon and commended his year as captain.
- Acknowledged the work of everyone involved at Kilcock GC.
- > Thanked everyone on the committee for their work throughout 2022
- Mainly used one bank account with €3,219 in credit.
- ➤ Majority of our income is through BRS system and processed through the JMC account, were in receipt of €7,250 in physical funds through the following-
 - JMC Transfer €6,500
 - Sponsorship €250
 - Golf Ireland Grant €500 this was facilitated for the juniors which Tony Dempsey applied for.
- ➤ €7,890 was paid out this year from the bank. There were expenses paid by JMC on our behalf please refer to treasurer's report on the website for a full breakdown of the income and expenditure account.
- ➤ Previous years an annual budget is prepared as the same for 2022 with the finances to meet requirements.
- We had a great year this year with budgeted income against 2021 and we must remember Covid in 2021. YTD 2022 €108,942, 2021 €63,225 again with participants the actual is up against forecast actual 19,653 budget 16,045 great turn out and during his time As Hon treasurer this is by far our best year.
- Weather- 19 cancellations this was up against 2021 but Covid was in effect and impacted 6 months of competitions.
- Seniors Budget 4,160 Vs Actual 4,651 we are also in the plus here which is great.
- Friday Opens (Incl. Final) Budget 2,500 Vs Actual 3,267 again another competition in the plus and great to see the success of the Titleist open with some competitions lost to weather.
- > Breakdown of competitions are as follows....

Regular Club Competitions – Budget 5,500 Vs Actual 6,218

Despite losing 7 planned events to poor weather, we exceeded the budgeted numbers by 718 over the year.

Bank Holidays – Budget 700 Vs Actual 1,036

We exceeded the budgeted numbers by 336 over the year.

Major Events (Excl. Medals) – Budget 1,280 Vs Actual 1,765

We exceeded the budgeted numbers by 485 over the year.

Monthly Medals - Budget 1,120 Vs Actual 1,765

We exceeded the budgeted numbers by 530 over the year.

Club Match Plays - Budget 315 Vs Actual 42

Spring League - Budget 120 Vs Actual 161

Captains Drive-In - Budget 140 Vs Actual 134

Scratch Cups – Budget 160 Vs Actual 280

Super Seniors – Budget 0 Vs Actual 15



- Committee continues to review the prize structure and they have been quite fair with the prizes this year and must remember that we also need to remain profitable as a club.
- We have requested the Turkey vouchers as last year through Super Value and are not processed through the accounts.
- Competition accounts are part of the men's committee remit however the JMC look after this.
- Cormac again highlighted the contribution of running the club at 40K and complimented that it was the highest he has seen during his time.
- Cormac highlighted with importance that of our finances Obviously, this is confidential information, so I would ask that should you print down this information that you either keep it safe or dispose of it in the appropriate manner.
- Cormac wanted to inform the meeting and committee that during his seven years he has really enjoyed the position and thanked previous committees and members for their support and help over the years. He will kindly assist with helping the treasurer settle into the role once appointed.

4. Competition Secretary report: Presented by Mick Cronin

- Thanked everyone for attending this evening.
- Mentioned we were only open on the previous two years and hard to compare this year against them

- Open Competitions 79
- Total Golf Rounds 19,088
- Visitors Golf Rounds 1,460
- Competition Days Course Closed (weather) 20
- Prizes given out 1,546
- Mentioned that the no of round played was 19,088 and the average on the previous 5 was 12,500.
- Our biggest turnout was the away day at Lucan GC with 165 playing on the day. On average we had 100 players per competition which is fantastic to see.
- Compliments to Captains Day winner John Tyrell winning narrowly on countback.



- Compliments to Presidents prize winner Damien Garton winning comprehensively.
- Medal winners 2022; April Aidan Gough, May Philip Flanagan, June Shay Fagan, July Martin Maguire, Aug Eamon Rheinisch, Sep Padraig Forde and for the first time ever we had a gold medal winner which was a playoff of all the medal winners, this was won by Martin McGuire.
- ➤ Golfer of the year, which went to the final day and the winner was Darren Gunning, congratulations to him and Gross Golfer of the year went to David Mahon.
- ➢ It was great to have our match plays and scratch cups up and running again after a long 2 years. Winners: Stephen Hannigan won the singles for the second time, the last time he won was 22 years ago. Other Matchplay Winners Gross David Mahon Fourball Martin Maguire & Michael Fahy Foursomes Tommy Tallon & Vincent McGoldrick Scotch David Ryan & Niall Lyons.
- ➤ Titleist open; A special thanks must go to our club pro Greg who secured Titleist on sponsorship for the final day. Overall participants 2,383 with 791 visitors throughout 27 open events and great to see with David Rheinisch winning on the final day.

- Turkey competitions we had 20 during November and December with 133 Super Value vouchers awarded.
- > Spring League; 27 teams entered with eventual winners The Harley's (Joe Scales, Ray Rafferty, David Bohan, David Timmons, Brendan Lynskey, Brian O Hara.) well done.
- ➤ Hole in one, report has 4 mentioned and we must inform the floor that Liam Petterson made the list to make it 5 with Robbie Breen, John Flynn, Patrick Kavanagh and Eddie Ryan. Congratulations to all.
- Prizes: all prizes were received in the pro shop with the only presentations awarded to Captains, Presidents, Medal winners, match-play and GOY. There will be a presentation on the 18th December with golf on the day and food.
- ➤ Interclub- as mentioned by Pat earlier we had great success with the seniors, and we must highlight to our members to enter these competitions to improve our performances in the competitions that we enter.
- ➤ Pro shop- Mick paid a very special thanks Greg, Johnny, Ben and Arron who were instrumental in assisting Mick throughout the year. Well done to Rob and the course staff on maintaining such standards on the course over 2022.



- ➤ Competition committee: Tommy Tallon, Darren Gunning and Joe Scales a note of thanks individually for your help throughout the year.
- ➤ Wishes to incoming Captain Ken O'Brien and his committee for 2023.
- ➤ Question from the floor regarding the junior cup; In short, we can only look at this when we get more members applying to enter our inter club competitions as the same players are playing the Barton cup and it causes problems, we applied for the Barton cup as it was the premier event to enter. Answered by both Brendan Finlay and Mick Cronin.

5. Handicap Secretary Report: Presented by Jamie Ryan

- Welcomed and thanked everyone for attending. Mentioned that the report will provide a good overview of WHS and review of Handicaps this year.
- ➤ 41 new members joined in 2022 compared to 58 in 2021, this decrease was on account of covid again playing its part. All new members now have Handicaps and reviewed on a rolling 3-month basis.
- New system is in effect to monitor non returns and this has had a good impact with 68 no scores compared to 165 in 2021.
- ➤ Golf Ireland and HC committee are monitoring unsatisfied scores.
- ➤ 2022 HC committee addressed, new Handicaps, the annual review of handicaps (every Oct), and as per mentioned non return of cards, general play and WHS. Most new handicaps ended up gaining shots after initial award of HC.
- Break down as follows:

- Annual review, 2022 is being actioned and to be returned by November 2022, changes must be implemented by 15 December
- ➤ What's addressed- reports on members scores below or above their HC, competition vs general play, performance in team events and when last playing to their HC



- Non-Returns in competitions, overview- new system where a no return merits contact for an explanation where previously it was more. Now there will be penalty scores and 16 players who did not offer an explanation had the penalty applied. Repeat offenders will incur more severe penalties. 1st time offenders may be given a pass, but they must offer an explanation.
- Members need to know that they are playing in competition and non-returns causes problems to the competition committee when closing competitions down the competition.
- General play-Players are monitored for intent to submit a score and do not submit one, they must remember that GUI are also watching this and will be contacted.
- ➤ WHS- Questions around high HC & low HC winning prizes with the higher HC winning more frequently.
- Report was submitted through our weekly newsletter explaining the monitoring of scores in the club. 53% prizes go to HC less than 20= 62% of prizes this year as an example. The new system is working and taking time to level out and hopefully this progress's more in 2023.
- ➤ If members have any questions relating to this, they can always communicate with the HC secretary. The reports demonstrate and show that more players are playing closer to their HC.
- Questions arose from the floor, where they questioned the low HC winning more prizes and none of the majors. Mick C and Jamie offered their response stating that the average score of a low HC was more consistent scoring in the 30-point range. In addition to this the overall query states that all golf clubs are experiencing settlement into the new WHS and that this was the first full year in competition, and it will take time.
- In addition to this we are addressing all aspect of the player from demographics, scoring to monitor the playing HC. They will be reviewed on a monthly basis new the HC award and more
- ➤ Pat Mahon complimented the response from the committee, and it was agreed that it was satisfactory and that WHS is working.
- ➤ Jamie carried on and sent his thanks to HC committee Mick Cronin, Mick Kenny, Des O'Loughlin and Peter O'Toole for their help throughout 2022.
- Thanks to the Pro shop with Greg and Johnny being very co-operative and helpful.
- Thanked Pat Mahon for the year as Captain and the committee for their support throughout the year.
- Wished incoming Captain Ken O'Brien a great year ahead.

- > Reminder that the senior's dinner will occur before Christmas with presentations to follow.
